Open Monday to Friday, entry fees apply. Please ring prior to visiting.




Boat Mountain Scenic Drive

Boat Mountain Conservation park is north-east of Murgon. Head north from Murgon along Gore Street which becomes Boat Mountain Road. Travel 9km along Boat Mountain Road then turn right into Reifs Road. After 0.6km, turn left into Daniels Road, continue 1.4km then turn right into Hebbel Drive and drive another 1.4km to the park.

Parts of this drive are steep and winding so its best to leave the caravan in town.

Spectacular views are your reward for the short walk to the top.

- 2. Sample local wines and produce at one of the many wineries in the area.
- 3. Take a scenic drive around the countrymaps available at the Murgon Visitor Information Centre.

Bjelke-Petersen Dam

Stay overnight at Bjelke-Petersen Dam and feel like you've escaped from everyday life to catch up on the things that matter. Bring the caravan, tent or treat yourself to a comfortable cabin of your choice.

If you want to bring the family – PERFECT – as there is a pool, tennis court, basketball court and play equipment, toilet, hot shower facilities and camp kitchen located on-site. No need to worry about packing the fridge, as there is a kiosk on-site for essentials and the township of Murgon is only a 10-minute drive away.

Spend your time enjoying all types of water sports – kayaking, tubing, knee boarding, water and jet skiing – and a spot of fishing.

If you are planning on doing some fishing, don't forget to organise your fishing permit.



Boat Mountain Conservation Park

This distinctive flat-topped ridge, shaped like an upturned boat, is a landmark near Murgon. See panoramic views across the South Burnett - ripening crops form a colourful tapestry across the surrounding countryside.

This small park has four walking tracks ranging from 370m to 2.2km. Naturalists, photographers and birdwatchers will also enjoy this park.
