1. Reasons for the Decision

The reasons for this decision are:

- Undertaking an Impact Assessment in accordance with the Planning Act allows for the evaluation of a development's merits. In this instance, despite the noncompliances with the Rural residential zone code assessment benchmarks and Reconfiguring a Lot Code assessment benchmarks, the development is deemed to present adequate merit to achieve an appropriate outcome regarding the relevant aspects of the Strategic Framework of the South Burnett Regional Council Planning Scheme 2017 v2.0, particularly the Settlement Pattern and Rural Futures themes. The development does not compromise the balance of the Strategic Framework.
- The Regional plan supports future rural residential development to be contained in existing rural residential zoned areas. Subject to planning and engineering considerations (such as wastewater codes), variation in minimum lot size may be used to support further rural residential opportunities.
- The development supports the additional supply of land for rural residential purpose that supports the management of residential growth in rural areas without fragmenting rural zoned land for rural residential purpose.
