The Youth Council is a group of up to 20 young people aged between 12 and 24 years old who meet regularly to discuss youth issues, help organise youth and community events, take part in leadership forums and self-development activities. The Youth Council has input into South Burnett Regional Council ('Council') decisions and are appointed to a one (1) year term.

Youth Council members are empowered to:

- talk to other young people to find out what important issues they are facing;
- provide advice to Council to ensure the voice of young people are heard;
- create and organise youth community events and initiatives to make young people feel safe, supported, and engaged; and
- work with other community groups to make our community a great place to be for everyone who lives here.

Youth Council members over the age of 18 will be required to hold a current Working with Children Blue Card, and all Youth Council members must adhere to Council's Employee Code of Conduct.

Youth Council members are appointed as individuals, rather than as representatives of any specific area or organisation. The selection process may involve an interview to ensure that all members are committed to making a positive difference in their communities.
