All participants must register their intention to conduct baiting. This will allow sufficient time to receive your baiting information pack and ensure all notification and administrative requirements are met prior to attending the baiting station.

Owners of domestic and working dogs are advised to restrain and/or muzzle their dogs during the baiting program to minimise the risk of dogs wandering and coming into contact with poison baits.
